Dear Ms. Harris:

As you may recall, LCRA Transmission Services Corporation (LCRA TSC) and Central Texas Electric Cooperative (CTEC) are working together to add electric infrastructure to serve a growing area of Gillespie, Kerr and Kimble counties in Texas. Your organization was originally contacted about this project in April 2018.

LCRA TSC hosted an open house for the proposed project on June 26, 2018 in Mountain Home. Since then, LCRA TSC has expanded the study area and added additional alternative transmission line route segments, including some segments connecting to the existing Ingram Substation. Therefore, LCRA TSC is hosting a second open house for landowners located near the newly added alternative route segments.

The open house will be on Wednesday, Nov. 7, from 6 to 8:30 p.m. at the Ingram Tom Moore High School cafeteria, 700 State Highway 39 in Ingram. The general public and potentially affected landowners are invited. Landowners who are potentially affected are people listed on the current county tax rolls as owners of land within 300 feet of the center line of the proposed preliminary transmission line route segments.

The open house will have an informal format consisting of staffed information stations addressing specific aspects of the project. LCRA TSC will not give a formal presentation. Visitors are encouraged to "come and go" and review each station at their own pace and ask questions.

Your input is important in evaluating alternative routes for the transmission line and assessing potential impacts. LCRA TSC requests that your agency/office provide any information that could affect the transmission line route in this area by **Nov. 23, 2018**. Specifically, we ask you to consider any impacts that involve:

- Environmental and land use constraints
- Current or proposed land development or infrastructure projects
- Construction projects
- Other areas of interest within the study area

Additionally, we would appreciate receiving information about any of the following conditions that you believe could affect this project:

- Permits

- Easements
- Other required approvals by your agency/office

LCRA TSC will request the approval of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for this project. We have enclosed a list of frequently asked questions explaining the project and providing additional information.

POWER Engineers, a consulting firm hired by LCRA TSC for this project, has identified several preliminary alternative transmission line route segments and substation sites for consideration. They are shown on the enclosed map. Maps with greater detail and additional project information will be available at the open house. The preliminary route segments and alternative substation locations are subject to modification based on further study and information gathered at the open house.

We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to seeing you at the open house and receiving your reply by Nov. 23, 2018. If you have any questions, please contact me.
